
### **Vowel Sounds**

#### **Instructions:**


Help your child cut out the picture pieces along the dotted lines and place them faceup on a flat surface. Encourage your child to look at one picture piece at a time and say the name of the object shown. Then invite him or her to write the missing short vowel on the piece to complete the word. Finally, prompt your child to place the picture piece on the vowel train that shows the same vowel sound. Continue until your child has sorted all the picture pieces!

### **Helpful Hint:**


Before you begin, review the words and short vowels on the mat together. Point to each picture on the mat and say the word: clock, fish, cat, sled, and bug. Ask your child to repeat the words. Then, point at the underlined letter in each word and say the vowel sound: /o/ for clock, /i/ for fish, /a/ for cat, /e/ for sled, and /u/ for bug. Point to each letter again and ask your child to repeat the short yowel sound.
