#### **Instructions:**

Cut along the dotted lines of the mat pages and tape the mat together. Cut out the game cards and game pieces along the dotted lines. Shuffle the game cards and place them facedown on the game mat. Place your game piece on the START space. Select a game card, read the sentence, and decide what type of sentence it is. Check the answer key. If you are correct, move your game piece to the next space showing that answer and place the card in a discard pile. If you are incorrect, stay where you are and put the card at the bottom of your pile to try again later. Keep playing until you reach the FINISH space! You can play this game by yourself or with a friend!

### Helpful Hint:

There are three main types of sentences: declarative, exclamatory, and interrogative.

**Declarative sentences** are statements and end with a period (.).

Example: My uncle drives a blue car.


**Exclamatory sentences** show excitement and end with an exclamation point (!).


Example: Get out of the way!


**Interrogative sentences** are questions and end with a question mark (?).
