**3** Pretend that you are visiting a favorite U.S. city on a family trip. Write a make-believe story about what you and your family do during the trip.



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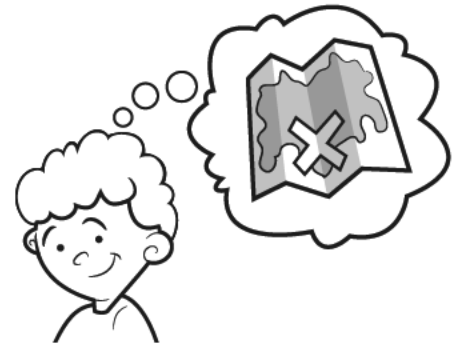
