Capitalization Rules

Proper names are always capitalized. They include people, places, and organizations.

Example: My sister Ellen and I are getting ready for school. **Example:** We are going to Florida during summer vacation.

Example: My father volunteers for the Red Cross.

Titles are capitalized when they are attached to a name.

Example: I like **M**rs. Anderson.

Example: My mom is taking me to **D**r. Kelly for a checkup.

Example: Governor Smith gave a speech last night.

Holidays, months, and days of the week are always capitalized.

Example: Tomorrow is **I**ndependence **D**ay!

Example: Five children in my class have birthdays in October.

Example: We are going to the park on **S**aturday.

Punctuation Rules

Apostrophes are used to show possession and to form contractions.

Example: Terry's dog is named Buster.

Example: I can't believe we get to go to Disneyland!

Commas are used when listing a series of things.


Example: I am taking swimming trunks, a towel, a hat, and toys to the beach.

Commas are used to separate parts of an address.

Example: I live at 145 Highland Place, Monrovia, California.

Commas and quotation marks are used to show when people are talking.

Example: Sarah said, "Come to my party this weekend."
