

Add a Bug!


Addition

Instructions:

Help your child cut out the bug pieces along the dotted lines and place them faceup on a flat surface. Encourage your child to solve the addition problems on the activity mats by first counting out the correct number of bug pieces for each number in a problem, and then counting the total number of pieces. Invite your child to write his or her answer in the circle on each leaf. Continue until your child has completed all the problems on both mats.

Helpful Hint:

Explain to your child that the addition symbol (+) means that the first number will be added to the second number. The equal sign (=) is placed at the end of the problem to show the total quantity of the two numbers.

$6 + 2 = \bigcirc$

$7 + 1 = \bigcirc$

$1 + 3 = \bigcirc$


$4 + 3 = \bigcirc$

$2 + 4 = \bigcirc$

$7 + 2 = \bigcirc$

$5 + 3 = \bigcirc$

$1 + 1 = \bigcirc$
